



To access the website

Note: this is from the desktop version. The appearance is slightly different on mobile, but the process is similar.


Go to <http://www.mrwalton.ca> (Note: because it is not https, some browsers will warn you that it is unsecure. Select “Advanced options” in the warning pop-up and “continue to site”).



Under “Available Course”, select your course.



Select "Access as a guest".



Enter the password provided to your class and "Submit".

Daily plans for each lesson are posted in **General > Announcements**, which you can also access from the side-bar.

Important dates for major assignments and tests are posted in the **Calendar** (available in the right-hand side-bar).

All notes, handout, worksheets, answer keys, etc. are posted in the main section and organized by unit.
